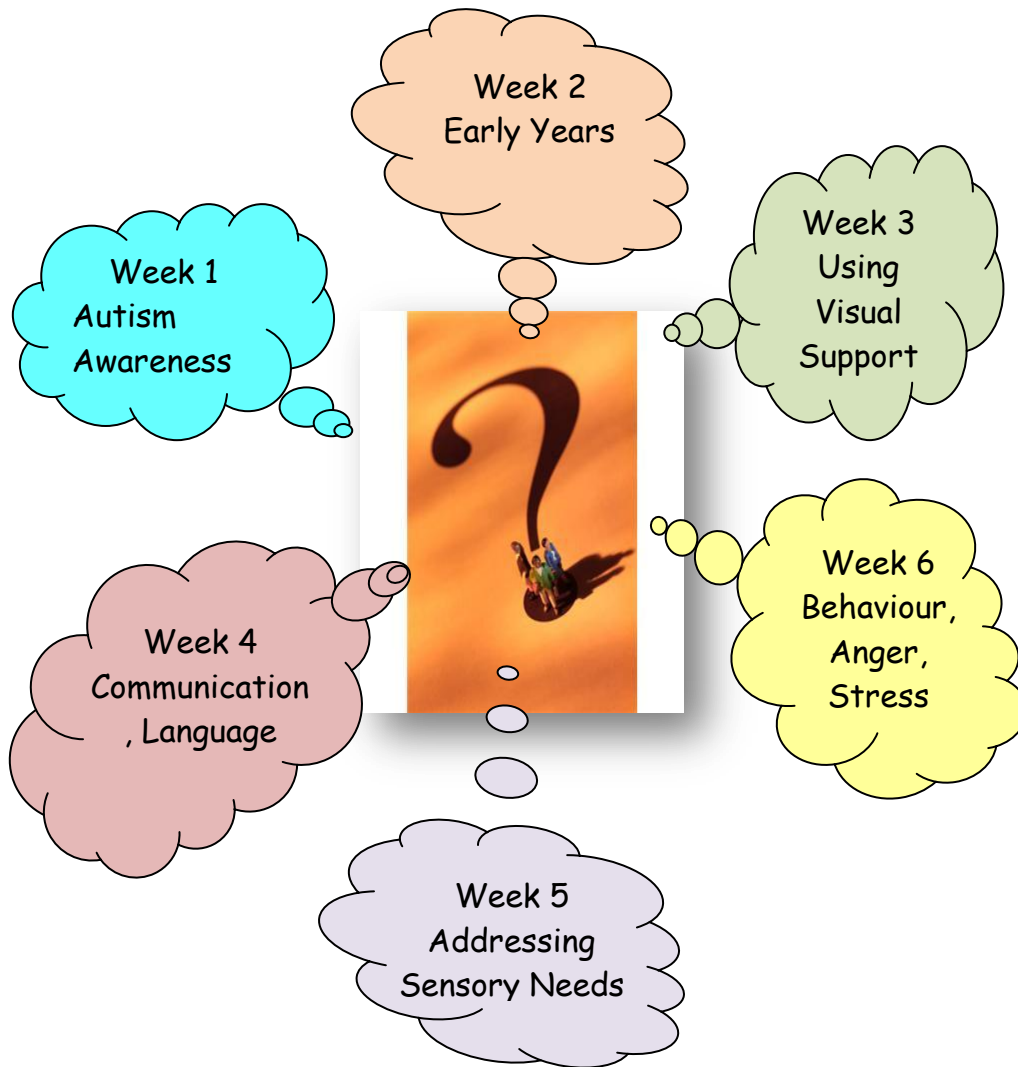


## Training for parents of children up to age 11 with a diagnosis of Autism
