## Planned Expenditure for September 2014- July 2015



School Sports Premium Funding will continue this year to make an impact in physical education for our primary children at Knowsley Central School. The government is providing, substantial primary school sport funding for this academic year. The amount we will receive will be calculated by the number of primary aged pupils (aged of 5 and 11) in school on the school census day. We will receive a lump sum of £8,000 plus £5.00 per pupil. Schools have to spend the money on improving their provision of sport and PE so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles.

At Knowsley Central we have links with Knowsley Schools Sports Partnership and over time have commissioned highly skilled specialist coaches in gymnastics, boccia, football, yoga, dance, judo, wheelchair basketball and other multi sports.

The funding will further develop PE provision, enhance competitive sport and support our teaching team in delivery of high quality PE lessons.
