

SPORTS PREMIUM GRANT

Planned Expenditure for September 2015- July 2016 - Draft



School Sports Premium Funding will continue this year to make an impact in physical education for our primary children at Knowsley Central School. The government will be providing, substantial primary school sport funding for this academic year. The amount we will receive will be calculated by the number of primary aged pupils (aged of 5 and 11) in school on the school census day. We will receive a lump sum of £8,330. Schools have to spend the money on improving their provision of sport and PE so that all primary pupils develop healthy lifestyles.

At Knowsley Central we have positive links with Knowsley Schools Sports Partnership and over time have commissioned highly skilled specialist coaches in gymnastics, boccia, football, yoga, dance, outdoor pursuits and other multi sports.

The funding will further develop PE provision, enhance competitive sport and support our teaching team in delivery of high quality PE lessons.

The funding will be used to resource the delivery of physical and wellbeing initiatives to enable and sustain focussed support to raise standards in PE and encourage healthy lifestyles.

The key initiatives will include:

- Sports coaching to support healthy lifestyles
- Increase competitive sport
- Extend outdoor activities at Barnstondale Adventure/Activity Centre
- Co-teaching with sports coaches
- Sports clubs – signposting and supporting with resources

Expected Impact of School Sports Premium Funding:

- Increased confidence and sense of achievement for pupils
- Pupils accessing a range of outdoor and adventurous activities
- Successful participation in competitive sport
- Signposting pupils to local sports clubs and associations
- Primary pupils accessing PE sessions from specialist coaches
