- **Well done to Classes Blossom 1 and Rowan who have 100% attendance this week.**

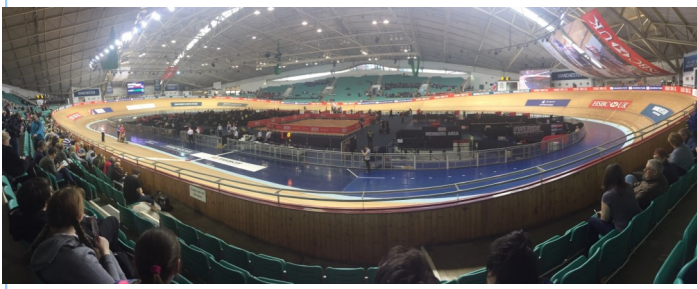

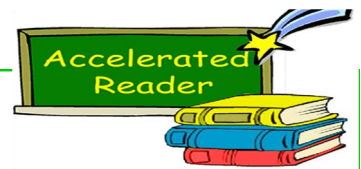
