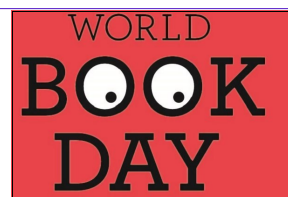
- Pupils photographs are now available from the office, priced at £6 per pack which includes 2 photos

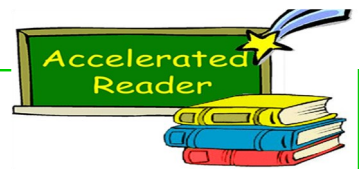
