- This week has been Mental Health Awareness Week. The children have enjoyed lots of activities including meditation and yoga.



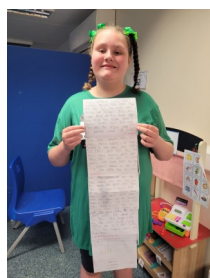
- Congratulations to Ava, Anthony and Francis for receiving their 'Star of the Week' certificates.

The pupils and staff are identifying acts of kindness throughout the school.

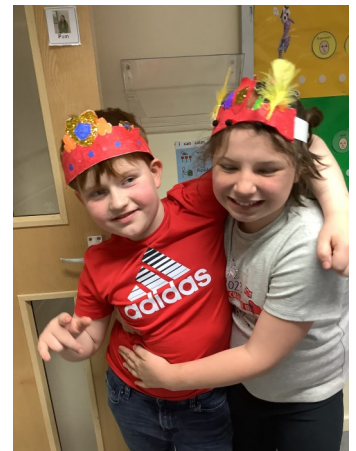
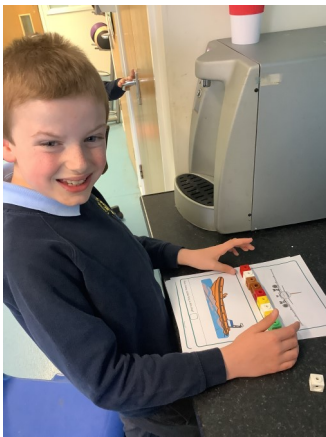
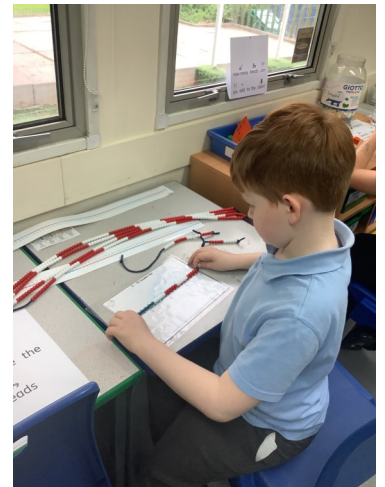
