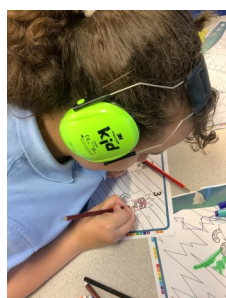
Our celebrations this week: Friday 17th May 2024

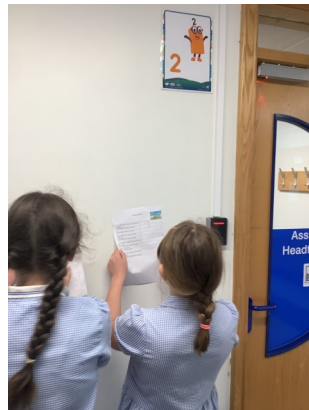
