Evie from Class Holly is our bookworm of the week.



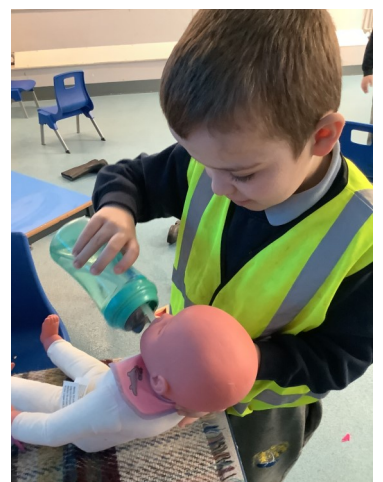
