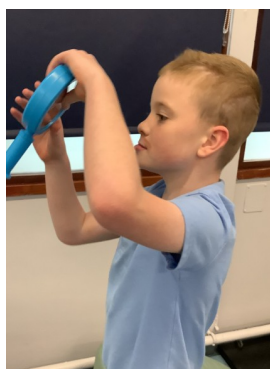


Our celebrations this week: Friday 19th September 2025
